

TUITION AND FEES

North Carolina A&T State University is moving to a per-credit hour tuition and fee rate for students beginning Fall 2021. This means that all new students and continuing students, who are not part of the *NC Fixed Tuition program, will be billed at a per-credit hour rate.

***The NC Fixed Tuition Program states:** *Effective with the fall 2016 semester, as required by North Carolina General Statute § 116-143.9, tuition rates at all UNC institutions will be fixed for eight consecutive semesters for all resident bachelor's degree-seeking freshmen. Tuition rates for other currently enrolled resident undergraduates and eligible transfer students will be fixed for an appropriate number of consecutive semesters. The per-credit hour tuition and fee rate is a University of North Carolina System-wide initiative, effective for all UNC System schools starting this fall.

How This Effects Your Bill

- Tuition and fee rates will be assessed *per credit hour* enrolled starting Fall 2021. Tuition and fee rates will no longer be assessed using block rates.
- Effective for Fall 2021, charges will be based on the Degree Program (whether your degree is an on-campus program or an on-line program).
- On-Campus degree programs will be billed the regular on-campus tuition and fees rate for all courses, even if some of the courses are offered in an on-line format.
- On-line degree programs will be billed at the distance learning tuition and fee rates for all courses.
 - Please note: students residing in university housing in an on-line program will also be assessed on-campus fees. Fees can be found on the schedule of tuition and fees.
- All tuition and fees will be capped at the full-time enrollment level of 12 (Undergraduate) and 9 (Graduate) credit hours.

What is **NOT** Changing

- A continuing undergraduate student in the [NC Fixed Tuition Program](#), will continue to be assessed on a block rate method. The new per-credit hour rate change does not apply to tuition and fees.

Some programs have differential tuition and/or program specific fees. Programs with these charges can be found on the schedule of tuition and fees.
