REVERSE TRANSFER PROGRAM

UNIT POLICY- ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

The Reverse Transfer Program (RTP) enables students who transfer to North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University from one of the 58 North Carolina community colleges to fulfill their requirements for an associate's degree while working towards their bachelor's degree. In order to be eligible to participate in the program, the students must have enrolled prior to the awarding of an associate degree and must have earned at least 16 college-level credit hours at one community college that will apply toward their associate's degree.

A student who is awarded an associate degree through the RTP will have fulfilled the general education requirements at North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University according to the guidelines established in the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA) if the following requirements are met:

- 1. the student is awarded either their associate in arts or associate in science degree, and
- 2. transferred with less than 12 remaining college-level credit hours to complete the associate's degree.
