SPECIAL NON-DEGREE-SEEKING STUDENTS

UNIT POLICY—ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

Special students are those who are not candidates for a degree. This category includes visiting students and persons who have not enrolled for one academic year and are ineligible for admission as a transfer student.

The University welcomes into this admission status enrollment of persons who are pursuing degrees elsewhere and are in good standing, who possess a baccalaureate degree, or who desire to earn prerequisites for graduate work. Such students may register upon the presentation of appropriate documentation from his/her institution, or certifying agency, specifically approving the course to be taken. Such enrollment does not constitute regular admission to the University.

To apply for this category of admission, the applicant must submit the application form for admissions with the fee and supporting documentation. Visiting students may register for no more than 12 credit hours per semester and a maximum of 50 semester hours.

After completing one semester of full-time study or its equivalent, the non-degree-seeking/visiting student may petition the Office of Undergraduate Admissions to be admitted to the university as a regular degree-seeking candidate on the basis of his/her academic accomplishments.
