ADMISSIONS OF STUDENTS SEEKING A SECOND BACHELOR'S DEGREE

UNIT POLICY--ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

If an applicant is interested in a second bachelor's degree at North Carolina A&T State University and the first bachelor's degree **was** obtained from a regionally accredited college or university, all general education requirements for the second bachelor's degree are satisfied. North Carolina A&T State University will accept no more than 90 hours of undergraduate credits from previous regionally accredited four-year institutions or approved international institutions.

Students seeking a second degree are expected to complete a minimum of 25% of the total hours required for the selected major at North Carolina A&T State University.
