NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENT ADMISSION AS UNDERGRADUATE

UNIT POLICY--ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

Any person 21 years of age and older (by the time of the first day of classes, according to the University's academic calendar) is considered a non-traditional student and may be considered for undergraduate admission as a first-time student after submission of the following:

1. A completed admission application;
2. Submission of the application fee;
3. Submission of official high school transcript or GED.

Per UNC Policy Manual 700.1.1.1[R], students 21 years of age and older, are exempt from minimum high school gpa, test scores, and course requirements. Being exempt from these requirements does not guarantee admission.
